NOTES AND CONDITIONS

Postal bids are welcomed! They will be logged in order of receipt; if equal bids are submitted, the one received first is the winner (So get in early!). A bidding form is attached. Please be sure to get the lot number correct – if you want (say) Lot B32 but write B23 on your bid form, then you are obliged to take B23 if your bid wins it.

Bids may be submitted by mail, e-mail, or telephone. The last-named will be logged as having been received at the time of the call, but for clarity and to avoid errors they MUST be confirmed in writing (postal or electronic), along with the bidder's name and address.

Please note that to allow for processing, there is an ABSOLUTE deadline for receipt of bids:

23:59 hours on Monday 15 October 2018.

This will be strictly adhered to, no exceptions – if you miss it, you will have to come to Banbury and bid in person.

Bidding Steps: Up to £5, 50p; £5 - £20, £1; £20 - £50, £2; Over £50, £5. Bids falling in between two steps will be rounded down to the lower step.

Bids less than the reserve will not be accepted (even if you think the lot is over-priced!).

Bids must be for a specific amount, "Buy" or "At Best" or similar will not be accepted.

You may set a maximum total spend if you wish, but bear in mind that the auction is basically room-based "live" and is not solely postal, therefore lots are taken in strict alphanumeric order as in the list.

Submission of a bid implies that you understand and will abide by the conditions set out in these notes.
