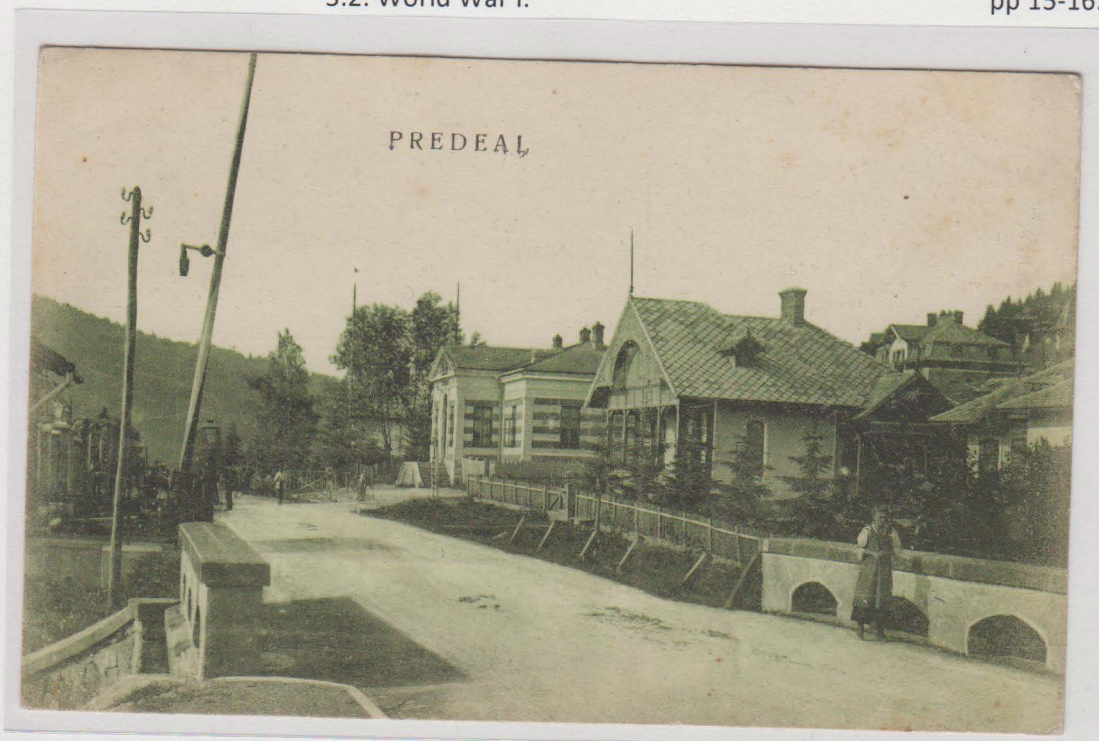


Hungarian Post in Romania II. - Predeal

In philatelic circles, the topic of Hungarian post in Romania reminded everyone about the six post offices of Bucarest, Galatz, Ibraila, Plojesti, Giurgevo and Fokschan, and the period from 1st May, 1867 to 31st March, 1869. However, there is another equally interesting, barely known period in the history of the Hungarian Post, when a post office was operated on the territory of Romania (25th February, 1881-28th April, 1904).
