

1.1. Hungarian Post in Romania I. (1867-1869): Bucarest and Galatz

Following the Austro-Hungarian Compromise, on the 1st May, 1867 six of the twelve Austrian post offices in Romania were placed under Hungarian administration. Soldi stamps were used in these offices until the 31st March, 1869, when their Hungarian administration ceased.



Pair of 5 Soldi red stamp on a letter from Bucharest (Romania) to Vienna (Austria) with date 21st September, 1867. On the back arrival postmark: Vienna, 29th September, 1867.



15+15+10 Soldi stamps on letter from Galatz (Romania) to Marseille (France), dated-14th July, 1868.
