

4.3. Baranya 2nd Issue Overprinted Postal Stationery

All original Hungarian postal stationery envelopes had a red border. This was possibly to make them stand out as they were all for registration. In some cases the 35f imprint was invalidated by a Serb control handstamp but in this example the 150f Baranya 2nd issue overprint served that purpose.



Express registered stationery letter from Pécs to Pécsvárad, Pécs cancel 3 Jan 1920, Baranya 2nd issue 150f overprint on 35f imprint, uprated 200f on 75f Parliament. Registration 100f, Express 100f, letter rate 50f, total 3.50k being the correct franking. Purple boxed Serb censor cachet. Receiving mark on reverse dated 7 Jan 1920.
